

KLINEO General Privacy Policy

KLINEO is incorporated as a simplified joint stock company (S.A.S.) with capital of €15,000, registered with the NANTERRE Trade and Companies Register under number 904 525 706, with its registered office located at 6, rue des Bateliers, 92110 CLICHY.

We are particularly concerned about the protection of personal data and comply with Law No. 78-17 of January 6, 1978, relating to information technology, files, and civil liberties, known as the "Information Technology and Civil Liberties" law (the "Data Protection Act") and European Regulation 2016/679 of April 27, 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, known as the General Data Protection Regulation or GDPR (the "GDPR").

We have chosen to use a certified "HDS" ("Health Data Host") hosting provider, offering the most advanced guarantees in terms of the standards established by the ANS ("Digital Health Agency").

The purpose of this Policy is to inform Patients, Physicians, Visitors, and Prospective Users of the KLINEO Platform about the Personal Data collected and processed by KLINEO and/or Referring Physicians when they use the Platform and/or KLINEO Services.

The Policy is accessible at any time at the bottom of the Platform.

SPECIFIC PROVISIONS FOR PATIENTS

IN WHAT CONTEXT DO WE COLLECT YOUR DATA?

Personal Data concerning Patients is collected by KLINEO:

1. Either directly from them, when creating or adding to their Patient Accounts. In this case, the creation of the Patient Account constitutes the Patient's consent to the processing of their health data, in accordance with Article 9.2.a of the GDPR.
2. Either with their Referring Physician, when the latter creates a Patient file, after obtaining the Patient's consent and duly informing them of their rights by providing them with the [Patient Information Sheet](#).

Patients' Personal Data may also be collected automatically when using the Services or browsing the KLINEO Platform. This automatic collection may be carried out in particular through the use of cookies and other trackers.

WHAT ARE THE PURPOSES, LEGAL BASES, AND DURATIONS OF OUR DATA PROCESSING?

In accordance with the regulations, any processing of Personal Data must, in order to be lawful, be based on one of the legal grounds set out in Article 6 of the GDPR.

Personal Data is collected and processed for a limited period of time depending on the purpose of the processing and applicable legislation. At the end of the retention period, the Personal Data of Patients and Visitors is permanently deleted or anonymized.

Depending on the data processing operations carried out, KLINEO may act as Data Controller or Data Processor on behalf of the Referring Physicians.

In the context of Processing carried out as a Subcontractor, KLINEO acts solely on the instructions of the Data Controllers and does not itself determine the legal basis or the retention periods for Personal Data. For security reasons, KLINEO may nevertheless implement default retention periods.

For any questions regarding the legal basis or retention periods for Personal Data for which KLINEO is only a Processor, we recommend that you contact your Referring Physician directly, as the Data Controller.

Personal Data concerning Physicians is collected by KLINEO:

1. Either directly with them, when creating or adding to their Referring Physician or Investigator Accounts,
2. Either by one of their Patients, when the latter creates their Patient account.

Doctors' Personal Data may also be collected automatically when using the Services or browsing the KLINEO Platform. This automatic collection may be carried out in particular through the use of cookies and other trackers.

WHAT ARE THE PURPOSES, LEGAL BASES, AND DURATIONS OF OUR DATA PROCESSING?

In accordance with the regulations, any processing of Personal Data must, in order to be lawful, be based on one of the legal grounds set out in Article 6 of the GDPR.

Personal Data is collected and processed for a limited period of time depending on the purpose of the processing and applicable legislation. At the end of the retention period, the Personal Data of Patients and Visitors is permanently deleted or anonymized.

Depending on the data processing operations carried out, KLINEO may act as Data Controller or Data Processor on behalf of Referring Physicians. If you have a Referring Physician Account, we invite you to refer to the Data Protection Agreement included in the Appendix to your General Terms and Conditions for Physicians, in addition to this Policy.

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SPECIFIC PROVISIONS FOR VISITORS AND PROSPECTIVE USERS

IN WHAT CONTEXT DO WE COLLECT YOUR DATA?

Personal Data concerning Visitors to the website may be collected automatically when using the Services or browsing the KLINEO Platform. This automatic collection may be carried out in particular through the use of cookies and other trackers.

Personal Data concerning prospective Users may be collected directly from them when they use the contact form available on the Website.

The contact details of prospective physician users may also be collected from Patients, who are asked to provide the identity of their physician when creating a Patient Account on KLINEO.

In accordance with the regulations, any processing of Personal Data must, in order to be lawful, be based on one of the legal grounds set out in Article 6 of the GDPR.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS?

In accordance with current regulations, you have, with some exceptions:

- the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning you are being processed and, where they are, access to said personal data as well as to several pieces of information about our processing operations (**right of access – Article 15 of the GDPR**);
- the right to obtain the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you (**right to rectification – Article 16 of the GDPR**);
- the right to obtain from us the erasure of personal data concerning you in certain cases (**right to erasure or "right to be forgotten" – Article 17 of the GDPR**);
- the right to obtain restriction of processing in certain cases (right to restriction of processing – Article 18 of the GDPR);
- the right to receive the personal data you have provided to us, in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format, and/or to request that we transmit this data to another data controller, where the processing is based on consent or on a contract and the processing is carried out using automated means (right to data portability – Article 20 of the GDPR);
- the right to obtain, for reasons relating to your particular situation, that we no longer process your personal data in certain cases (**right to object – Article 21.1. of the GDPR**);
- the right to object to the processing of your personal data for marketing purposes (**right to object to marketing – Article 21.2. of the GDPR**).
- the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing that produces legal effects concerning them or similarly significantly affects them (**right not to be subject to automated individual decision-making – Article 22 of the GDPR**) – our processing operations are not affected.

The existence or otherwise of these various rights depends in particular on the legal basis for the processing to which the request relates.

HOW TO EXERCISE YOUR RIGHTS?

If we have reasonable doubts about your identity, we may ask you for additional information or documents to verify your identity (for example, in some cases, a black and white copy of the front of your ID card).

1. When KLINEO acts as a Subcontractor for a Referring Physician:

In this case, we invite you to contact your referring physician directly, who will be able to answer your questions.

In both cases, you also have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority (in France, this is the Commission Nationale de l'Informatique et des Libertés, or CNIL).

SECURITY & ACCOMMODATION

Personal Data is stored in France at OVH Cloud. This hosting provider is certified "HDS" ("Health Data Host"), in accordance with the law and standards established by the ANS ("Agence du Numérique en Santé" - Digital Health Agency), in consultation with the CNIL ("Commission nationale de l'informatique et des libertés" - National Commission for Information Technology and Civil Liberties).

This certification attests to advanced security measures to protect health data hosting centers, ensuring the confidentiality of said data.

Privacy by design: KLINEO ensures that protection and security data is taken into account in the planning and development of its Services.

TO WHOM ARE WE LIKELY TO TRANSFER YOUR HEALTH DATA? ARE WE LIKELY TO TRANSFER YOUR HEALTH DATA OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC AREA?

All Health Data is hosted on OVH Cloud servers that are certified as Health Data Hosts (HDS) and are located exclusively in France.

All our employees and subcontractors are bound by confidentiality and security obligations and provide sufficient guarantees in accordance with the regulations in force.

With regard to the processing of Personal Data that is not Health Data (e.g., support services), we may use subcontractors that are not located within the European Union.

If the transfer takes place to a third country where the legislation has not been recognized as providing an adequate level of protection for Personal Data, we ensure that the necessary measures are put in place, in accordance with the French Data Protection Act and Articles 46 and 49 of the GDPR.
